**WORLD CAMPAIGN
BEING PLANNED**

**Minister Says Need is Great
For Evangelism in the
Present Age**

The world's campaign of Evangelism, as outlined by the Inter Church World Movement, was the theme of Dr. J. E. Snyder of Corvallis in his sermon at the First Presbyterian church of this city yesterday. Dr. Snyder, spoke in the place of Dr. Poling.

He set forth the need of the world evangelism and co-operation of all the church forces and workers. He said that never in the history of the world has there been so much crime and blood shed as during the last few years. The slogan of the Inter Church World Movement is to "characterize the world in this generation." The sin of lust and greed are the curse of the world. The world is in a deplorable condition, said he, and the teaching of that great teacher is the only cure to bring the world into right relationship.

Dr. Snyder attended the Inter Church Conference in Portland last week where he stated that more than 60 churches of this state united and 400 ministers were in attendance in the greatest convention he had ever attended in his life. Other similar conventions are to be held in other states and countries to assist in a com-

bined effort to work out a world program for the evangelism of the world. Revivals of the past have been local. Nations must rise or fall together. They are inter-dependent, said the speaker.

The world program, is not the federation of the churches, or to be led by professional evangelist, but simply the co-operation of all churches in the promotion of the kingdom of God. A revival of the layman and each one doing personal work. Dr. Snyder stated that in his own experience he had accomplished more by personal work than in any other way.

The church is an asset and not a liability, from a financial stand point, said Dr. Snyder. Take the church and its influence out of your town and real estate would not be worth 40 cents on the dollar. He stated it was the purpose of the new movement to take into the church on Easter Sunday a million members. Dr. Snyder set forth as a fundamental, the importance of prayer as a pre-requisite to the success of the movement and cited prayer as a source of strength to the great leaders of civilization.
