Announcement of the trust is contained in a letter to Superintendent Boettcher which reads as follows: "I have this day placed in trust with the First Savings Bank of Albany, Oregon, the sum of one hundred dollars, with instructions that this amount shall be held in Trust perpetually by the First Savings Bank for the Public Schools of Albany, and that the First Savings Bank shall invest this amount and that the annual return from the investment shall be given as a prize to the young lady in the Senior Class of the High School who is most proficient in sewing."

"The conditions upon which the award is to be made are to be fixed from time to time by the Superintendent of the Public Schools of Albany, in consultation with the Teacher of the Domestic Science Department. It is my desire that this prize be awarded annually at Commencement Time at the end of the School year."

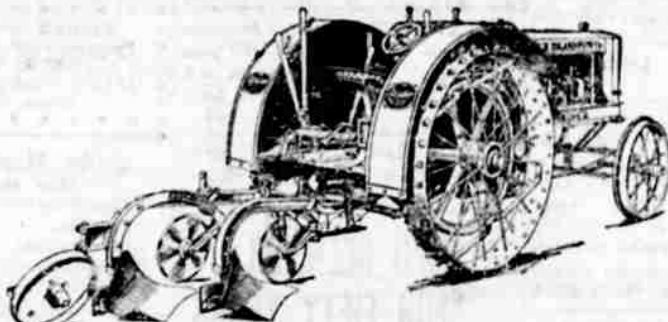
