endorsed a plan presented by the state board to raise \$244,000 in Oregon for the extension of the Salvation army home service.

Delegates of their own accord added \$40,000 to purchase and reopen the Bishop Scott school and 100 acre farm near Yamhill for a Salvation army industrial home and agricultural school to take care of minor cases of delinquent children and also for orphanages.

A hundred delegates heard Commissioner Estill of Chicago explain the work of the Salvation army among the women and Dr. Charles T. Wheeler tell of the work on the battlefields. John L. Ethridge was chosen to handle the financial campaign and his organization which will be built throughout the state will be backed and aided by the county advisory boards.

Budget endorsed by the county advisor boards is to be raised half in Multnomah county and half in outside counties. Representatives of the counties present went out to the White Shield home which is being taken over by the Salvation army as its rescue

home.

RULES FOR FILING PETITIONS STATED

Three classes of candidates will seek nomination at the coming primaries in May and the various regulations to which they must subscribe in order to insure having their names on the ballot have been emphasized in an announcement made today by County Clerk Russell.

Candidates at large for state offices are required to file their petitions with the secretary of state 35 days before the primaries. At least 2 per cent of the number voting for the member of Congress of that district at the 1916 election are required to sign the petition.

The same ruling applies for district officers as regards time of filing petitions. As regards the signers they must represent at least 2 per cent of the number of voters in the district at the last congressional election.

For county candidates the petition must be filed with the county clerk at
