

SAW MILL SWAMPED.

No Orders Will be Booked for Immediate Delivery.

Manager Stoddard, of the Sumpter Lumber company, states that he will not book any more orders for lumber, agreeing to deliver at an early date.

To add to his troubles, he has met with two annoying incidents during the past week. One is a dispute with the Sumpter Valley road over freight charges on six carloads of lumber from the Bridal Veil mills, which has arrived and for which customers are clamoring.

The company now has on file, so Mr. Stoddard informs THE MINER, orders for lumber with which to build more than twenty residences and a half dozen business houses.

Just as soon, however, as the differences with the railroad are adjusted, lumber will be rushed in from the outside and the local trade taken care of, and Mr. Stoddard knows how to do it.
