

Money for Hilgard-Granite Road.

Mr. Robert Smith returned Tuesday from Chicago, where he went a few days ago in the interests of the Hilgard-Granite railroad. Mr. Smith states that if no more than half the tonnage that has been assured can be had, money enough to complete the road to Granite will be forthcoming. And he confidently believes that there is abundant tonnage to justify the building of the road. This road is not, he says, conditioned by a possible road from Sumpter to Granite. It has its own country to draw upon, and will scarcely be affected by such a road as is proposed at Sumpter. The company is now paying \$100 per day for engineering work, and the enterprise is by no means wholly speculative.—La Grande Journal.

ORDINANCE NO. 47.

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF CITY PHYSICIAN FOR THE TOWN OF SUMPTER.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the Town of Sumpter, Baker County, Oregon:

SECTION 1. The office of City Physician of the Town of Sumpter is hereby created, said City Physician to be elected by the Common Council of the Town of Sumpter and to serve at the pleasure of the Council.

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the City Physician of the Town of Sumpter to attend and prescribe for any patient who may have a contagious disease within the Town of Sumpter, when requested so to do by the Health Officer of said town or any person whom the Council of said town shall direct to be prescribed for by order of the Common Council.

SEC. 3. The compensation of the City Physician shall be fixed from time to time by the Common Council of the Town of Sumpter.

Passed the Common Council and approved by the Mayor this 20th day of January, 1900.

ORDINANCE NO. 48.

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE TOWN OF SUMPTER.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the Town of Sumpter:

SECTION 1. The office of Health Officer is hereby created, said Health Officer to be elected by the Common Council of the Town of Sumpter and to hold office at the pleasure of the Council.

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the Health Officer to care for the general health of the Town of Sumpter and to have full authority to quarantine any contagious disease within the town.

SEC. 3. The Health Officer of the Town of Sumpter shall be ex-officio a police officer of said town.

SEC. 4. The compensation of the Health Officer shall be fixed from time to time by the Common Council of the Town of Sumpter.

Passed the Common Council and approved by the Mayor this 20th day of January, 1900.

ORDINANCE NO. 49.

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE MAINTAINING, CONDUCTING, OPERATING, PLAYING OR USING A NICKEL-IN-THE-SLOT MACHINE OR ANY DEVICE OF LIKE CHARACTER WHEREIN ARE USED CARDS, DICE OR ANY SUBSTITUTE THEREFOR OR WHEREIN THERE ENTERS ANY ELEMENT OF CHANCE WITHIN THE TOWN OF SUMPTER, BAKER COUNTY, OREGON.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the Town of Sumpter:

SECTION 1. Each and every person who shall conduct, maintain or operate either as owner, proprietor, lessee or employee, any nickel-in-the-slot machine or other device of like character wherein are used cards, dice or any substitute therefor or wherein there enters any element of chance, whether the same be played or operated for money, checks, credit or any other thing or representative of value, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.

SEC. 2. Each and every person who shall, as owner, proprietor, lessee or employee, permit any minor to play any nickel-in-the-slot machine mentioned in section one of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than fifty dollars nor less than twenty dollars or imprisoned in the city jail not more than twenty days.
