MINING ON DEER CREEK

District Close to Town Shows up Rich in Free Gold.
J. T. Baldwin has been working his Lucky Baldwin claim on Deer creek, four miles east of town. From the feet of tunnel work, to cross cut a vein which had been opened higher up the mountain, he brought in some fine specimens of ore, several of which carries free gold, which is plainly visible.

The Deer creek section is receiving considerable attention this summer. Several parties having located what promise to make mines. Mr. McCallum, cousin of the Bald Mountain mine manager, has with others been developing a group of claims in this locality, and exhibited some fine specimens of ore. Samples which, it is said, run from \$6.40 to \$29 in gold, according to assays made in Portland, Spokane and Montreal.
