

IT IS announced from Washington that United States Attorney General Griggs holds that every lease and sale of public lands in the Hawaitan Islands made since September 28, 1800, is illegal and void. Suits will be instituted at once to set aside every such sale.

PRESS reports say that Secretary Long announces that an agreement has been reached whereby the armor plate companies agree to furnish armor at a substantial reduction of the price mentioned in their bids, which was \$400 per ton for the very best Krupp. The details of the agreement have been refused.

THE total vote in Baker county at the national election last week was 3125, registration being 4124. Four years ago he had a clear majority of 909, with a much smaller vote.
