David Wilson Buys Lots on Which to Build Them.

Mr. Wilson is not a lot speculator, and this property was purchased for his usual purpose, that of sites for buildings. During the coming summer he will erect about a dozen residences, to be rented. He has secured excellent locations and the new houses, with modern conveniences, will surely be in demand.

Rich Ore From the Sunrise.

S. H. Bell, W. C. Calder and E. E. McCammon have incorporated the Sunrise Mining company, with an authorized capital stock of \$1,000,000, par value of shares \$1. These gentlemen, with A. C. Little and W. F. Dillon, of Tacoma, constitute the directorate, from which officers will shortly be elected. The properties of the company are the Sunrise and Sunset claims in the Greenhorn district. A series of open cuts on the Sunrise is said to show a three-foot vein, from which assays of \$57.45 and \$223.62 are reported. It is the intention of the company to drive a crosscut tunnel of 500 feet, which will tap the vein at a depth of 350 feet, and later on to drive a crosscut tunnel of 1100 feet, to be started lower down, which will tap the vein at a depth of about 700 feet. —Blue Mountain Eagle.

Portlanders Coming to the Gold Fields.

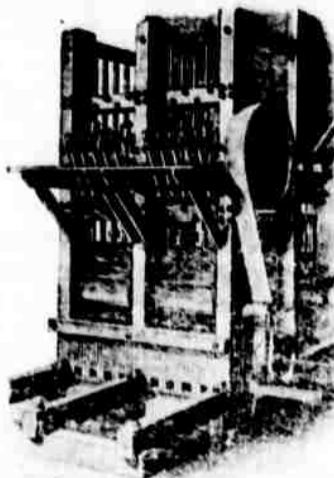

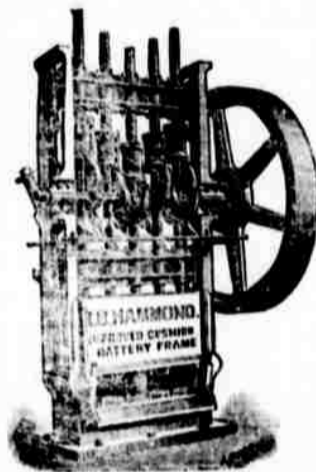
