SUIT OVER GIPSY KING STOCK.

Interesting Legal Complications Arent Title to a Pooled Block.

When two men go into the courts to fight for the possession of a piece of property, it is a very good evidence that the object of contention is of more or less value.

A summons has been issued to Peter Eibach to defend his title to a block of Gipsy King Gold Mines company stock. George Fronhoffer is plaintiff in the case and N. C. Richards is his attorney.

An interesting legal point is involved in this suit. The block of stock held by Eibach is a part of the pool of 750,000 shares now in escrow in the First Bank of Sumpter, which according to the by laws of the company can not be released until January 1, 1902. Should the plaintiff win the suit, another would have to be instituted in order to get possession of the stock, and at that point of the game, all kinds of legal complications would arise. The defendant did not sign the pooling agreement, the stock at that time being in the name of another, but the transfer was made just previous to placing the whole amount in escrow and was included in the original agreement.

This suit, of course, does not in the least effect the treasury stock, which alone can now be bought at any price. Nor does it interfere in any way with the affairs of the company. The progress of the suit, however, is watched with much interest by the other stockholders, to see what process, if any, can be employed to withdraw the block from the pool.

Resume Operations at the White Swan.

Letson Balliet, general manager of the White Swan Mines company, limited, who, through the failure of the old owners of the White Swan mine to redeem the judgment held by him within the time re-

quired by law, recently acquired complete control and possession of that famous property, will at once commence operations on an extensive scale. From the offices of Mr. Balliet's company in this city it is given out that the old shaft will be unwatered as soon as possible, and development work promptly inaugurated. An examination of the shaft reveals the fact that it is in much better condition than was anticipated. It is not believed to be seriously caved, and will only need re-timbering. To unwater the shaft is an undertaking of some magnitude, but it has been pronounced perfectly feasible. New hoisting works and pumps will be installed at an early date, and the rich bodies of ore known to exist in two different submerged levels will be promptly converted into bars of gold bullion. The first shift of men will be placed at work Monday, primarily to prepare the to-stamp mill for a run of Carrol B ore, and then the work of unwatering the shaft will be inaugurated.—Baker City Herald.
