Cripple Creek Gold Production.

Cripple Creek February gold production reached \$2,058,000, against \$2,100,000 last month. The tonnage was 12,500 smelter ore, worth \$875,000, and 36,200 mill ore, worth \$1,173,000. The camp's output for the fiscal year is \$23,247,000, the grand total to date being \$92,143,287. Production is not being rushed owing to lack of transportion and treatment facilities. The conditions will change during March with a sixth railroad entering the field and new mills starting. Out of two months' production as given, \$611,000 dividends have been paid, \$181,000 being the February record.

Through the efforts of J. F. Batchelder, of this city, Oregon's mining exhibit at the Pan-American exposition, at Buffalo, will include perhaps the only specimens of cobalt ore that will be found at Buffalo. This ore comes from the Standard mine in Prairie City district, and as far as known is the only cobalt found in this country. The shipment to be made to Buffalo consists of 765 pounds and includes several chunks weighing from 50 to 200 pounds each .- Portland Telegram.
