

ORDINANCE NO. —

AN ORDINANCE TO RESTRICT THE ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP OF THE SUMPTER VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT.

The City of Sumpter does ordain as follows: Section 1. That the active membership of the Sumpter Volunteer Fire Department, to whom compensation shall be allowed for services at fires in the City of Sumpter, and who shall be exempt from the payment of poll, street, road and other taxes under the ordinances of the City of Sumpter, is hereby limited to sixty members.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Secretary of the Sumpter Volunteer Fire Department to prepare and file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Sumpter, a list of the active members of said Fire Department, which list shall show the date upon which each member of said Department became a member thereof, and which list may be revised from time to time by said Secretary, but said list shall not at any time contain more than sixty names.

Section 3. Any person claiming any exemption of privilege by reason of being an active member of said Sumpter Volunteer Fire Department, shall not be entitled to such exemption or privilege unless his name appears on said list of active members of said Sumpter Volunteer Fire Department, and in case the exemption claimed is relief from the payment of a road, street or poll tax under any ordinance of the City of Sumpter, such exemption shall not be allowed unless it appears by said list that the person claiming such exemption has been an active member for one year or more of said Fire department preceding the levy of such tax.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SIDEWALK ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF MILL STREET, FROM THE SOUTHERLY SIDE LINE OF LOT ONE (1), IN BLOCK B, IN THE SUMPTER TOWNSITE SYNDICATE'S THIRD ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF SUMPTER, TO AUBURN STREET.

The City of Sumpter does ordain as follows: Section 1. That a sidewalk not less than six feet in width to be constructed along the west side of Mill street, from the southerly side line of Lot One, Block "B," in the Sumpter Townsite Syndicate's Third addition to Sumpter, to Auburn street.

Section 2. That said sidewalk be constructed in such way and manner and with such material as the City Engineer shall direct, but such sidewalk shall not be less than six feet in width.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SIDEWALK ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF NORTH STREET, FROM MILL STREET TO BONANZA STREET.

The City of Sumpter does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a sidewalk not less than six feet in width be constructed along the south side of North street, from Mill Street to Bonanza street.

Section 2. That said sidewalk be constructed in such way and manner and with such material as the City Engineer shall direct, but said sidewalk shall not be less than six feet in width.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SIDEWALK ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF AUSTIN STREET, WITH THE NECESSARY CROSS WALKS, FROM MILL STREET TO IREX STREET.

The City of Sumpter does ordain as follows: Section 1. That a sidewalk not less than six feet in width be constructed on the south side of Austin street, from Mill street to Irex street.

Section 2. That said sidewalk be constructed in such way and manner and with such material as the City Engineer shall direct, but said sidewalk shall not be less than six feet in width.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SIDEWALK ON THE EAST SIDE OF COLUMBIA STREET, FROM NORTH STREET TO PINE STREET.

The City of Sumpter does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a sidewalk not less than six feet

in width be constructed on the east side of Columbia street, from North street to Pine street.

Section 2. That said sidewalk be constructed in such way and manner and with such material as the City Engineer shall direct, but said sidewalk shall not be less than six feet in width.

ORDINANCE NO. —

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SIDEWALK ON BOTH SIDES OF AUBURN STREET, WHERE THE SAME IS NOT NOW LAID DOWN, FROM MILL STREET TO BONANZA STREET.

The City of Sumpter does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a sidewalk not less than six feet in width be constructed on each side of Auburn street, wherethe same has not already been laid, from Mill street to Bonanza street.

Section 2. That said sidewalks be constructed in such way and manner and with such material as the City Engineer shall direct, but such sidewalk shall not be less than six feet in width.

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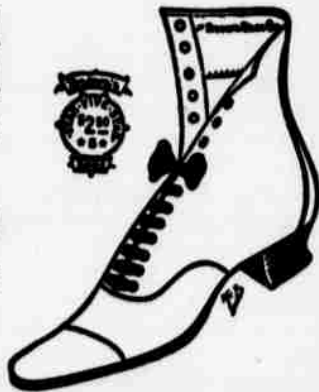
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
