

GOOD CLAIMS IN THE COVE.

Northup & Konkle, the Lucky Prospectors, Win Out Again.

F. W. Northup and Charles Konkle are working two groups of claims about two miles west of Big Limber creek, in the Cable Cove district, which they recently located.

On another claim they have sunk about twenty feet on a parallel ledge, eight feet in width, and found a highly mineralized ore, that is being assayed and is thought will show considerable values.

The formation is granite and gneiss, exactly the same as found in the majority of the properties in Cable Cove district.

Mr. Northup says the veins in the district are blind ones, all covered with wash and not easily located; in fact the ones they are now working on were prospected some years before by other parties, who abandoned them because they could not find the ledge, though their work, which is now caved in, was within a few feet of the same.
