Decision in Famous Ella Mine Case.

A press dispatch from Boise says: Judge Beatty, of the United States court, handed down a decision for the defense in the famous case of Patrick Clark et al vs. Charles Sweeny et al, involving the ownership of the Ella claim, adjoining the Tiger-Poorman at Burke, in the Cour d'Alenes. Sweeny purchased the Ella from plaintiffs for \$4000. It was claimed afterward that he secured it through misrepresentations and fraud, it being asserted that the property was then worth \$1,000,000. Suit was brought for cancelation of the transfer. It has been a sensational pr-ceeding throughout and has attracted a great deal of attention. Referring to the charge that the Ella was clandestinely explored, the opinion says: "While there is no evidence or authority for, or objection to what defendants may have done, it seems that since the time of Clark's management workings have been extended into this ground without question and acquiesced in, and it may have been because the old company owned the ground on both sides of the Ella. Sweeny says he found the works there and used them without knowing of any objection. Under such eirenmstances it can not be concluded that such possession was clandestine or for the purpose of defrauding the Ella owners." Patrick Clark said to a Spokesman-Review reporter, on learning of the adverse decision in his case against the Empire State-Idaho company: "Although we should have been more pleased to have won the decision, we are not at all discouraged at having lost it. This is but the opening round in this contest, and no matter who should have won, the case would have gone to the higher courts. We certainly expect to take it up before the court of appeals."
