THE Lead and Zinc News, of St. Louis, stated yesterday, so an Associated Press dispatch reports: What will be the greatest lead combination in this country is now nearing consummation. While its promoters are more than ordinarily reticent, it is definitely known that the scope of the merger will include most of the large white lead plants east of the Mississippi, the principal pipe and sheet lead plants, and a number of companies manufacturing products in which lead forms one of the chief components. Included in the merger will be the Union Lead & Oil company, ARIZONA CORPORATION CHARTER CO. which was organized last year by the

Ryan-Whitney coterie of capitalists, with a capital of \$10,000,000, and which controls the Bailey process of manufacturing white lead. Overtures made to induce the National Lead company to join the merger are said to be favorably looked upon by a portion of the directorate. Behind the merger are the Ryan-Whitney and American Smelting & Refining company interests. Options have been secured on a number of corroding plants of the country, notably the Chadwick company of Boston and the Raymond company of Chicago.
