While ite promoters are more than or dimarily reticent, it is sletinitely known that the seope of the merger will inclade most of the large white lead plants east of the Missinsippi, the principal pipe and sheet lead plants, and a number of companies mannfacturing products in which lead forms one of the chief somponents. Included in the marger will be the Union lasad is Oit company, which was organized last year by the

Ryan-Whitney coterie of capitalists, with a capital of $\$ 10,000,000$, and which controls the Bailey procens of manufacturing white lead. Overtures made to induce the Sational lead company to join the merger are said to be favorably looked upon by a portion of the directorate. Behind the merger are the Byan-Whitney and American Smelting is Refining company interests. Options have been secured on a number of corroding plants of the country, notably Hhe Chadnick compuny of Boston and the Raymond company of Chicago. If the merger is completed successfully it
