Mueller apneral manager of the corporation now controlling the merged proper tiom, in concentrating his efforts to ward the promecution of development work on an extended neale. Work han alroady boen begun, and the magnitude on which future operations are to be carried on will make the Ouartzhurg district one of the thont Qutive in the country surrounding the activ. Ir. Muellor, of the Killeng Warner, Stewart company, Khich is Warner, Stowart company, which i acting as authorized flacal agents and handling the stock, left early this week for the propetry, to carry for Ward the plans of the company already ontlined.
According to the policy of opera tion by Dr. Mueller the systematic plan of development will open up meven well demonstrated veins from the lowent level, giving a depth of 1,200 feet. Work on the Willie Boy aroment will be firat taken up. Thin tunnel in now in 480 feet and it in antimated will reach the Willie Boy aninatin within the next thirty or forty cin willin tho noxt thirty or forty leet, which, when it reachs the ledse, will give n depth of over 300 feet.

As moon ns this work is well under way similar plans will be carried ont in extending oxisting drifts on the Standard vein, further opening up there known ore bodies of great richneme. Then in turn like development work will be taken up on the Side lasue vein which promises
then on the Juniper and Ruby veins. All of this development can be carried on in ore with very little dead work. It will be meen that practically all of the rock taken out in driving theme drifts on these veing will be ore and will be aufticient to keep a large mill busy from simply keep a large mili busy from simply the duvelopment work without doing foot of stoping. It is not the intention of the management according to the plann made known to do any stoping at all for a long time, perhaph years, because it will be doing development work on so many different veins and in so many different places that the ore product will amount to a large tonnage each day. it will be meen also that this method contemplates the creation of auch im. mense ore renerves as will make this one of the most valuable mining assets in the country.
Bins are being constructed to recelve the ore that will be taken out In the development work under way intil a suitable milling and concenrating plant can be inatalled. The manaegment is not yet ready to give ny detalls as to the character or size of the plant, though it wan admitted that the mill will be of good size and horoughly up-to-date. A large comressor plant will probably also be nstalled. The company is to be ommended for these very conservaive and yet deiededly progressive plans and methods.
