### IMPERIAL READY TO SHIP ORE.

#### Cable Cove Road In Bad Condition, Increasing Freight Charges.

Captain A. M. Paul, superintendent of the Imperial mine in the Cable Cove district, stopped over in Sumpter Monday night on his way to Baker City to make application for a patent to this mining property. The Imperial group consists of fourteen claims situated between the Baby McKee and the California.

Captain Paul states that he is now prepared to ship ore, as soon as arrangements can be made with the smelter here, and the Cable Cove road is repaired so that transportation charges will be reduced to an equitable rate. About six miles of the Sumpter road is in fairly good shape, but the rest of it is in poor condition. If the roads were fixed, he says that the transportation from the mine to the smelter would be reduced at least one-fourth. The situation not only affects the Imperial, but the other companies in the Cable Cove district which have shipping ore. The county commissioners have the matter under advisement and it is probable that the road will be attended to.

Another object in his visit to the city was to see Dr. Mueller, manager of the smelter, and make arrangements as to smelting charges. The doctor was out of the city, however, and this matter could not be attended

to. Captain Paul says that he is preparing to start a drift on the 200 foot level and drift both ways on the ledge. There is a good showing to begin with.

#### HOIST AND TREATING PLANT.

Baby McKee Ready to Ship But Bad Roads Against It.

L. G. Lilley, superintendent of the Baby McKee, who is in the city this week, states that he is now ready to ship ore to the Sumpter smelter, but that the matter is held back on account of the bad condition of the Cable Cove road.

Work, he says, is progressing very satisfactorily at the Baby McKee. He is figuring on putting in a hoist, with a capacity of 250 feet depth, and will probably install a treating plant later on.
