

ORDINANCE NO. 191.

An ordinance establishing the grade of Granite Street from its intersection with Mill Street, Easterly to its intersection with Columbia Street, and to repeal Ordinance No. 175 of the City of Sumpter, approved Nov. 6th, 1902.

The City of Sumpter does ordain as follows:

That the grade of Granite Street from its intersection with Mill Street Easterly to its intersection with Columbia Street, in said City of Sumpter, Oregon, shall be as shown by the plat of said portion of Granite Street, prepared by C. H. Fenner, City Engineer, and approved May 21, 1903, and the courses, distances, levels, and grades thereon stated, which profile is on file with the Recorder of the said City of Sumpter, and is hereby referred to and made a part of this ordinance.

That Ordinance No. 175, new series, of the City of Sumpter, entitled: "An ordinance establishing the grade of Granite Street Easterly from its intersection with Mill Street to its intersection with the west line of Columbia," approved Nov. 6th, 1902, be and the same is hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 192.

An ordinance establishing the grade of Columbia Street from its intersection with North Street to its intersection with the North line of Lot 20 in Block 11, as shown on the plat of said Sumpter Height's Addition to Sumpter, Oregon, of record in the office of the Recorder of Baker County, Oregon, extended across Columbia Street, and to repeal Ordinance No. 176 of the City of Sumpter, approved Nov. 6th, 1902.

The City of Sumpter does ordain as follows:

That the grade of Columbia Street in the City of Sumpter, from its intersection with North Street to its intersection with the North line of Lot 20 in Block 11, as shown on the plat of Sumpter Height's Addition to Sumpter, of record in the office of the Recorder of Conveyances of Baker County, Oregon, extended across said Columbia Street, shall be as shown by the profile of said portion of Columbia Street, prepared by C. H. Fenner, City Engineer, and approved May 21, 1903, and the courses, distances, levels, and grades thereon stated, which plat is on file with the Recorder of the City of Sumpter, and is hereby referred to and made a part of this ordinance.

That Ordinance No. 176, new series, of the City of Sumpter, entitled: "An ordinance establishing the grade of Columbia Street from its intersection with Granite Street to its intersection with North Street," be and the same hereby is repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 193.

An Ordinance establishing the grade of Auburn Street from its intersection with Center Street Easterly to

its intersection with Ibox Street in the City of Sumpter.

The City of Sumpter does ordain as follows:

That the grade of Auburn Street from its intersection with Center Street Easterly to its intersection with Ibox Street in the City of Sumpter, Oregon, shall be as shown by the plat of said portion of said Auburn street prepared by C. H. Fenner, City Engineer, and approved June 4th, 1903, and the courses, distances, levels and grades therein stated, which profile is on file with the Recorder of the City of Sumpter, and is hereby referred to and made a part of this ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 194.

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Granite Street from the East line of Mill street to the West line of Columbia Street in the City of Sumpter, and repealing ordinance No. 177, new series, of the City of Sumpter.

Whereas due and legal notice of the proposed improvement of Granite street from the East line of Mill street to the West line of Columbia Street has been given by publication as by law required, and no legal remonstrance thereto has been filed by the owners of property liable for the cost of said improvement, and the time for filing any remonstrance thereto having expired,

Now Therefore the City of Sumpter Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Granite Street from the East line of Mill Street to the West line of Columbia Street in the City of Sumpter be improved by removing all obstructions therefrom, grading the same to the grade heretofore determined by C. H. Fenner, City Engineer, and established by ordinance of the City, and filling in the same to conform to said grade with natural dirt and rounding said street up in the center so as to give good drainage, by laying all necessary box gutters, and putting in curbs along the lines of said street.

Section 2. Said improvement shall be completed to the satisfaction of the City Engineer, as soon hereafter as practicable, and shall be completed within thirty days after the letting of the contract therefor, and from the time of commencing, said work, the same shall be pushed continuously until completed.

Section 3. Said improvement shall be made at the expense of the abutting property owners, as provided in the charter of the City of Sumpter, and the contract of said improvement shall contain a stipulation that the person or firm shall look only to the fund to be assessed upon the property liable for such improvement, and paid into the City treasury for that purpose, and that such contractor will not require nor attempt to require the City of Sumpter by legal proceedings or otherwise, to pay the same or any part thereof out of any other fund.

Section 4. The contract or contracts for said improvement shall also be subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 134, entitled "An ordinance to provide for the giving of bonds for the performance of contracts made by contractors of the City of Sumpter, and for the protection of laborers doing work and material men furnishing material on said contracts," and said ordinance shall be made a part of said contract.

Section 5. The City Recorder is

hereby authorized and directed to at once advertise for and receive bids for making said improvement, and the Committee on streets and public property of the City of Sumpter is authorized to enter into a contract for making said improvement specified in this ordinance, subject to the approval of the common council of the City.

Section 6. The City engineer is required to at once prepare an estimate of the probable cost of the improvement above proposed, the cost of engineering and superintendence, and file the same with the City Recorder.

Section 7. That Ordinance No. 177, new series, of the City of Sumpter, entitled: "An ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Granite Street from the East line of Mill street to the West line of Columbia Street, passed Nov. 5th, 1902, and approved Nov. 6th, 1902," be and the same hereby is repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 195.

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Columbia Street from its intersection with the South line of east Granite street extended westerly across Columbia street to the east line of block 11, Sumpter Height's, McEwen's Addition to Sumpter, to the south line of North Street in said city, and repealing Ordinance No. 178, new series, of the City of Sumpter.

Whereas, due and legal notice of the proposed improvement of Columbia Street from its intersection with the south line of east Granite street extended westerly to the east line of block 11, Sumpter Height's, McEwen's Addition to Sumpter, to the south line of North street in said city, has been given by publication as by law required, and no legal remonstrance thereto has been filed by the owners liable for the costs of said improvement and the time for filing any remonstrance thereto having expired,

Now, Therefore, the City of Sumpter Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Columbia Street from its intersection with the south line of east Granite street extended westerly across Columbia street to the east line of block 11, Sumpter Height's, McEwen's Addition to Sumpter, to the south line of North street in said city, be improved by removing all obstructions therefrom, grading the same to the grade heretofore determined by C. H. Fenner, City Engineer, and established by ordinance of the city, and filling in the same to conform to said grade with natural dirt and rounding said street up in the center, so as to give good drainage, by laying of box gutters, and the putting in curbs along the curb lines of said streets.

Section 2. Said improvements shall be completed to the satisfaction of the City Engineer and shall be completed within thirty days after the letting of the contract therefor, and from the time of commencing, said work shall be pushed continuously until completed.

Section 3. Said improvements shall be made at the expense of the abutting property owners as provided in the charter of the City of Sumpter, and the contract for such improvement shall contain a stipulation to the effect that the person or firm to whom such contract is let,

shall look only to the fund assessed upon the property liable for such improvement and paid into the City Treasury for that purpose, and that such contractor will not require nor attempt to require the City of Sumpter by legal process or otherwise to pay the same, or any part thereof out of any other fund.

Section 4. The contract or contracts for said improvements shall also be subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 134 entitled: "An ordinance to provide for the giving of bonds for the performance of contracts made by contractors of the City of Sumpter, and for the protection of laborers doing work and material men furnishing material on said contracts", and said ordinance shall be made a part of said contract.

Section 5. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to advertise and receive bids for making said improvement and the Committee on Street and Public property is authorized to enter into a contract for the improvement specified in this ordinance, subject to the approval of the common council of the city.

Section 6. The City engineer is also required to prepare an estimate of the probable cost of the improvement above proposed, including costs of engineering and superintendence, and file the same with the City Recorder.

Section 7. That Ordinance No. 178, new series, of the City of Sumpter, entitled: "An ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Columbia Street from its intersection with the North line of Lot 20, Block 11, Sumpter Height's McEwen's Addition to Sumpter, extended across said Columbia Street to the South line of North street in said city", approved Nov. 6th, 1902, be and the same is hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 196.

An ordinance providing for the construction of a sewer system in the City of Sumpter, directing the manner of estimating the cost of the same, and to provide for the issuance of bonds to defray the cost of the same.

The City of Sumpter Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed in the City of Sumpter, a sewer system in accordance with the map thereof and drawings thereof entitled "Map of sewer system of the City of Sumpter", the specifications thereof entitled: "specifications of sewer system", prepared by C. H. Fenner, City Engineer, and designed by Philbrick & Fenner, Civil Engineers, and the estimate of cost thereof made by said C. H. Fenner, City Engineer, all of which are now on file with the City Recorder of the City of Sumpter, Oregon, and are hereby referred to and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. That the cost of said sewer system shall be estimated as shown by the specifications and estimate aforesaid, prepared by said C. H. Fenner, City Engineer, the total cost thereof as shown thereby, to be the sum of \$15,000. That said sewer system shall be constructed at the expense of the entire city, the funds therefor to be raised by bonding the City.

Section 3. The bonds shall be issued by the City of Sumpter to the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars in accordance with the provisions
