

A standard measuse of investment has been generally adopted, by which a property owner should invest at least 3 per cent of the amount of his property and wage earners 5 per cent of the amount of his yearly earnings.

No soliciting will be done until every person has received their rating and has 'had opportunity to appear and make their pledges voluntarily.


