A letter from U. S. U'Ren of Portland to the Observer says:

Dear Mr. Wescott:— "A few days ago a friend sent me a copy of your paper, which accuses me of supporting the four per cent interest constitutional amendment. I am not guilty and never was; I have never said anything that would justify the charge.

The adoption of this amendment would be a calamity for the people of Oregon. Hundreds of such laws have been tried, and always increased the burdens of the farmers and wage workers. The rates of interest can be reduced by increasing the supply of money for loans on safe security faster than the demand increases, and not in any other way. Congress could do this, but it is beyond the power of any state.

I hope you will give this letter as prominent space as you gave the false charge, and I forgive you this time because you are a friend of mine, but please do not accuse me again of doing anything so foolish as advocating a

Entitled an ordinance regulating the construction of sidewalks on Main Street in the City of Aurora, Oregon. The people of the City of Aurora, do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. All sidewalks hereafter constructed on Main Street shall be made of concrete. Sec. 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Automobile Accidents

Sunday night while returning from Salem, Bent's car ran into a bug standing without lights on the pavement. The bug was out of gas and the driver was borrowing some from a Scotts Mills Overland with glaring head lights about 40 feet further along on the pavement on the opposite side. The Bent's car, going about 15 miles per hour, struck the bug, pushed it into the ditch and up the bank where it overturned, throwing out its woman occupant unharmed. The Bent's car then skidded across the pavement and bunted the Overland. All the cars were damaged, but the Bent's car more than the others—probably about \$200.

The glaring lights of the Overland, and the lack of a rear light on the bug caused the accident.

Mrs. George Andreas was quite severely injured in an auto collision which happened on the Pacific Highway Sunday just south of Hubbard. In passing a truck, the car driven by her husband collided head on with another car coming in the other direction. Mrs. Andreas' face was badly cut by the windshield.

A car belonging to the Marks brothers, Samuel and Clifford, was struck Sunday this side of Oregon City by a touring car. Paul Gooding was one of those who witnessed the accident, having been driving just behind the touring car that ran into the Mark's car.

HOW TO FEED CALVES

Feed the calf only small amounts of milk for the first few feedings.

Do not overfeed. Scours, stunted calves, and deaths are caused largely by overfeeding. A pint of milk weighs a pound. Measure or weigh the milk for each calf. Do not guess at it.

Feed regularly twice a day. Have the milk warm, sweet and fresh. If the milk is poor in quality, feed less of it, not more.

Feed grain and milk from clean boxes and buckets. Buckets should be washed and scalded every morning.
