COUNCIL BILL NO. 113

Entitled an ordinance regulating the
construction of sidewalks on Main
Street in the City of Aurora, Oregon.
The people of the City of Aurora,
do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. All sidewalks hereafter con-
structed on Main Street shall be made
of concrete. Sec. 2. All ordinances
or parts of ordinances conflicting with
the provisions of this ordinance are
hereby repealed.

this 13th day of Sept. 1920.
