Blanch a pound of Italian chestnuts, boil until tender and put through a ricer. Add one cup of bread crumbs, one-half cupful of shortening, one tablespoonful and a half of poultry seasoning, one-half cupful of raisins, and cayenne to taste.

Strain and add onefourth of a package of gelatin softened in one-fourth of a cupful of water; stir until the gelatin is dissolved then turn into a border mold. When ready to serve dip in tepid water, wipe, turn in the hand to make sure that the jelly is free from the mold and unmold on a chilled dish. 


