ADEQUATE SURPLUS

"Why do you increase your capital?" This was asked us by a depositor, as he noticed on our new calendar that our capital and surplus is now \$41,000.00.

We explained that this is primarily a protection tu our customers. Should a bank by some unusual circtmstance suffer a loss the undivided profits and surplus would first be applied to cover the loss. If this were not sufficient the Capital Stock fund would next be applied and should more be necessary the stockholders would each be required to contribute an amount equal to the par value of the shares of stock he might hold. The State Examiners make due investigation to see that each stockholder is able to meet this double liability.

From this it will be seen that there is a bufier of \$66, 000, standing between our depositors and any chance of loss, which amount any one will admit is many times greater than necessary. This is only in line, however, with our policy of "protection which protects" and "service that serves."
