SUMMONS

IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON, FOR MARION COUNTY.

In the Name of the State of Oregon: You are hereby required to appear and answer the complaint filed against you in the above entitled suit within six weeks from the 13th day of December, 1923, the date of the first publication of this summons, and if you fail to answer, for want thereof plaintiff will take judgment against you for the sum of Five Hundred Eighty-five 00-100 (\$585.00) Dollars, and her costs and disbursements incurred in this action, and a further order ordering that the hereinafter described attached real property be sold and the proceeds applied to the satisfaction of said judgment, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the Salem, Salem and Butteville road with the Champeog road, which point is South 76 1/2 degrees East 45.64 chains from the Northwest corner of the Gideon Senecal D. L. C. in Township 4 South, Range 1 and 2 West of the W. M. thence North 76 1/2 degrees West 45.64 chains to the Northwest corner of said claim; thence South 14 degrees West 47.43 chains to M.
