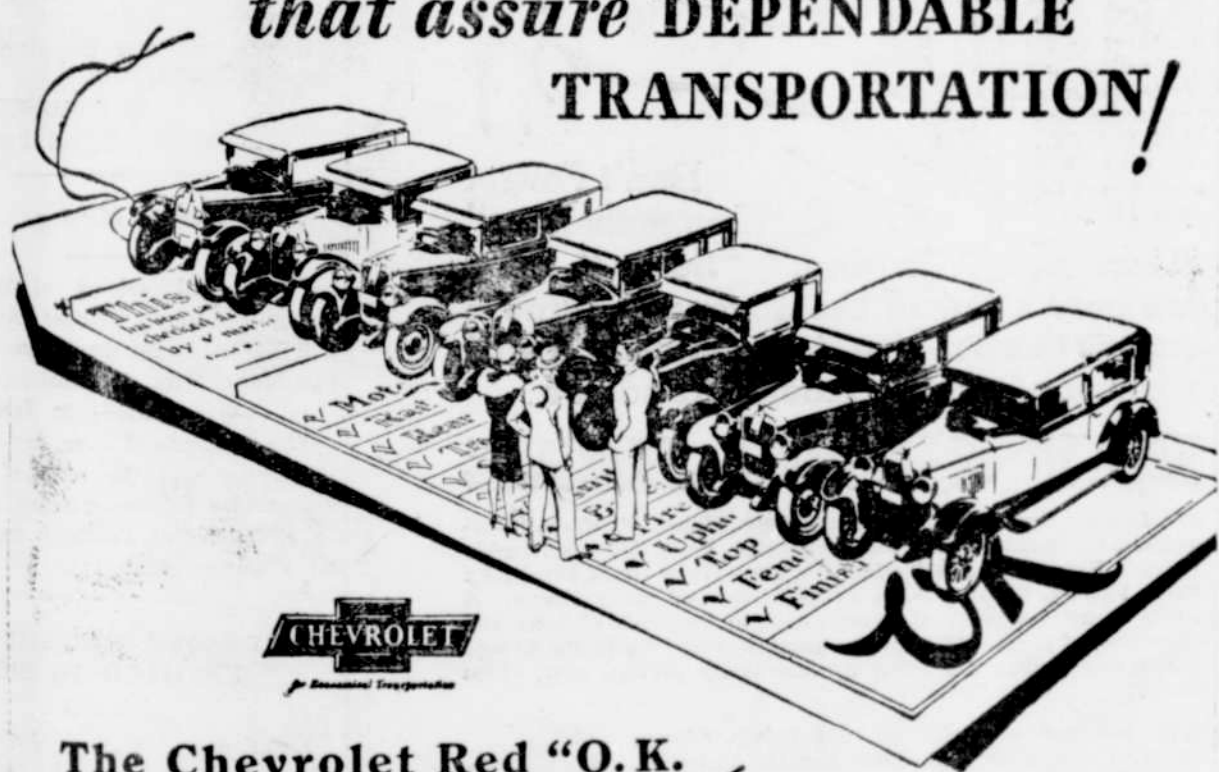

MANY NEW FAMILIES SETTLE IN OREGON

A steady stream of new people into Oregon is revealed by the May report of the State Chamber of Commerce which shows 75 new families who located in all sections of the state. These new people purchased 4154 acres of land and invested a total of \$260,900 in property. During the month the state chamber received letters from 89 families who stated they had received Oregon literature and decided to come to this state to locate. These prospective families will have \$204,700 to invest.

Other interesting figures of the May report are: 1486 letters were received from people interested in Oregon; 103 families signed the chambers questionnaire giving facts about what they were seeking in Oregon; 5429 letters were mailed to prospective families and 2865 pieces of Oregon literature were mailed; 352 people called at the Portland office.

The state chamber report for the first five months of this year likewise shows a very substantial increase in new families, acres of land purchased and investments made. New families for the first five months of 1928 were 122, compared with 232 for 1927; acres of land purchased in 1928 were 8230, compared with 12,544 this year, and investments made by new families rose from \$430,676 in 1928 to \$806,225 in the first five months of 1929.
