in the columns of this paper. You will find in a vacant store window near the postoffice practically all the figures that have been presented and you can quickly refresh your memory before you vote.

We consider this an important event in the affairs of Beaverton. We do not standardize our schools we stand to loose to Hillsboro if they now have one of the finest schools in the state of Oregon and already they have approached some of our students with the promise of transportation to Hillsboro. We are interested in the welfare and progress of our community, we love this little suburban community of ours; and have an abiding faith in its future are willing to sacrifice time and energy and a few dollars to need be to make that future sure. Some of you have no children—usually you have 'not the interest in our schools that we mothers and fathers have—we do not blame you for that—but will you not come out and help us in an unselfish way to give the boys and girls in our community an equal chance with boys and girls in other communities. Not only our own boys and girls but our busses go out for miles and bring in boys and girls from other communities that otherwise would not have a chance. It is worth our while. We do not believe that our youth are unworthy any more than we were unworthy in our day. Will you not adopt a broad unselfish attitude and vote "yes" with us for our young people and for Beaverton.

The Cost of Our School Building

In view of the fact that reports are being circulated regarding excessive cost of our proposed school plant the school board wish to go on record as follows:

1. We did our best to secure the advice of an excellent, experienced architect. One who has recently built a number of schools in Oregon. He estimates the cost to be not more than \$35,000.

2. The school board will not accept a contract for more than that and will do their best to make it less.

3. If the contract cannot be given out for \$35,000 or less they will start the building at all.

4. We shall see to it that the man who accepts the contract is bonded by a responsible Bonding company. If the contractor does not make good the Bonding Co. will make good.

It will not cost this district more than \$35,000.
