COUNTY AGENT NOTES

Of the fifty-seven potato growers who are growing certified seed not one grower was rejected on the first inspection. This is the first record of this kind for Washington county and is a contrast to several years ago when forty to sixty per cent would be ruled out on the first examination on account of disease.

The showing made at this time indicates that potato growers are eliminating the more serious virus diseases, and that the potatoes now being grown for seed are of more disease-free strain. Furthermore Washington county growers have thus far found a ready market for this improved stock.

The following potato growers of Washington county have had potato fields pass the first inspection for certified seed as given by the Farm Crops Department of the Oregon Agricultural college. The second inspection will be given in September followed by the third inspection among the potatoes that have been placed in storage.

White Holland wheat gave the highest yield of the fourteen winter varieties on trial in the Grain Nursery conducted by the county agent and the O. A. C. Experiment Station on the Ben Heesacker farm at Verboort this year. Applegate Red Chaff was second in yield and Jenkin Club third in a similar trial conducted in 1928 on the farm of Fritz Elmer at Sherwood. "Rink" wheat was first in yield and Jenkin Club second, while White Holland dropped to fourteenth place in 1927 on the Geo. Biersdorf farm. Jenkin Club ranked first; White Holland second, and White Winter third. Jenkin Club was the highest yielding wheat in the grain nursery trials on the Milne farm at North Plains in 1926, with Rink in second place.
