Roger Williams' Home

Providence (R. I.) was founded in 1636 by Roger Williams, who bought a tract of land from the Narragansett sachems and built a house at the confluence of the Moshassuck and Woonasquatucket rivers, and with a few followers set up a town government. In 1637, after a few more settlers had arrived, the plantation covenant was adopted embodying a complete sep aration of religious and civil affairs. It was incorporated as a town by the colonial assembly in 1649. The name

"What do we want of this vast worthless area, this region of savages and wild beasts, of deserts of shifting sands and whirlwinds of dust, cactus and prairie dogs? To what use could these endless mountain ranges, impenetrable and covered to their bases with eternal snow? What can we ever hope to do with the western coast of 3,000 miles, rock-bound, cheerless and uninviting, with not a harbor in it? Mr. President, I will never vote one cent from the public treasury to place the Pacific coast one inch nearer Boston than it is today."
