BROADCASTS FROM KOAC

Oregon Poultrymen Like Course

The KOAC radio course in poultry which has attracted such keen interest among poultrymen now has an enrollment of 503 in Oregon and 31 in Washington Idaho and California according to W. L. Kaddery, program director of the state college station. Marion county is still in the lead with 84 enrolled listeners.

"Feeding the Layers," is the next topic for the weekly lectures which are given each Tuesday night from 8 to 8:30 o'clock by A. C. Lunn, professor of poultry husbandry.

A long and diversified list of timely animal husbandry topics are on the KOAC program schedule for the early part of the new year, including management and marketing problems of sheep, cattle and horses. The animal husbandry hour comes each Friday night at 7:20 o'clock. The topic for Friday, January 7, will be "Wintering Draft Horses" by B. W. Rodenwald assistant professor of animal husbandry.

That it seems about time the members of the medical, dental and legal professions abandon their obsolete ethics as to newspaper advertising. No one outside of their own profession can understand their line of reasoning which forbids paid newspaper advertising.

The lawyer never objects when his local paper makes a report of a case he has won or a speech he has made which advertises him and his business. He never recoils from any favorable mention of himself.

The doctor never suffers by loss of dignity when the newspapers broadcast new discoveries that have been made by their profession to benefit mankind and which increase business for themselves.

People do not know the causes, preventatives and consequences of diseases as they should. They are entitled to know. Doctors should advertise these facts in paid newspaper advertising, using plain words so that the people may know and know in time so they can see their doctor.

Because quacks have misused newspaper space is just the reason why the legitimate doctors should advertise.

Too many people go to quacks and suffer thereby due to the lack of advertising on the part of the medical profession.

St. Louis with 10-cent carfare has not escaped the danger of hitting the red side of the ledger for the year. Signs read: "Do Your Shopping by Street Car." Down-town streets in the Missouri metropolis are like Portland's for narrowness. Parking is not permitted on the principal trade avenues. Outside the central business area set-back lines are being fixed and new districts have broader traffic lanes. Electric installation has increased rapidly as in other American cities, with provision for still greater volume. Regulations by state commission is declared satisfactory by citizens, and there is disposition to work with the utilities in solving transportation problems. Only two Missouri cities rank over 100,000 in population, Kansas City at the western edge, with St. Louis at the Mississippi portal. The latter gained 6.4 per cent in the decade since

1920; Kansas City grew 23.1 per cent, while Portland Oregon, shows nearly 17 per cent gain.
