### Sarah Anne's Cooking Class

**Berry Muffins**

2-3 cups flour,  
4 teaspoons baking powder,  
1-2 teaspoon salt,  
1-3 cup sugar,  
1 cup milk,  
1 egg beaten,  
1-4 cup butter,  
1 cup berries  
Mix and sift dry ingredients into a mixing bowl; add the milk gradually beating until smooth. Beat the egg without separating and add to the mixture, add melted shortening add berries which have been lightly floured. Pour in greased muffin tins and bake in hot oven (400 degrees) for twenty-five minutes.  
**Swiss Tomatoes**  
Select small regular sized tomatoes, scald chill and peel them. Then hollow deeply. Chop together enough boiled tongue and enough cheese to make four tablespoonful each, one thin slice of onion, a spray of parsley and two pickles. Mix with mayonnaise. Fill the tomatoes and serve on lettuce with mayonnaise  
2 large cucumbers,  
1-2 green pepper chopped fine,  
1 tablespoon chopped onion,  
1-2 teaspoon salt,  
2 tablespoons chopped parsley,  
2 tablespoons cider vinegar.  
Peel cucumbers, chop fine and drain off liquid. Add chopped pepper, parsley, salt, onion and vinegar Mix well. Chill and serve with roast beef.

**Frozen Melange**

Heat one-quarter cupful of orange juice with two tablespoons of lemon juice and dissolve it in a tablespoon of gelatine already softened in two tablespoons of cold water. Stir this into a cupful of ginger ale and half a cupful each of pineapple tidbits, quartered maraschino cherries and diced peaches, fresh or canned, a tablespoon of preserved ginger cut fine and two tablespoons of powdered sugar. Pack in ice and salt or in trays to electric refrigerator for four hours.

**Frozen Apricot Salad**

Heat in the double boiler one-quarter of a cupful each of apricot and orange juice, two tablespoons of lemon juice and a pinch of salt. Beat two egg yolks with half a cupful of sugar and stir the hot juices into them, then cook over hot water stirring until thick and smooth. Cool and fold in the stiffly beaten egg whites and one cupful of whipped cream and one and one-half cupfuls canned apricots cut into quarters. Pack in ice and salt or in trays of electric refrigerator for four hours. Serve on mint leaves garnished with a green mint cherry.
