**ON OREGON FARMS**

**EUGENE**—Lane county farmer, are showing more interest this fall for the control of noxious weeds, than ever in the use of chemicals says O. S. Fletcher county agent. During September five farmers purchased 672 pounds of sodium chlorate and 10 farmers purchased 800 pounds of atlatide. A number of others indicated their intention of purchasing chlorates for use during October and early November.

**KLAMATH FALLS**—Indications are that the Klamath Falls county potato crop this year will be about 80 per cent of normal, with an increased percentage of number twos, according to County Agent C. A. Henderson. Shipments increased rapidly during the latter part of September and early October, reaching a total of 25 cars a day.

**ROSEBURG**—By following the program advocated by the Oregon agricultural extension service, L. E. Thompson of Umpqua has made a profit on lamb production during the past season in spite of the relatively low prices received, he says. Creep feeding was begun when the lambs were 10 days old, and exceptional gains were made from the start. During the latter part of the feeding period Mr. Thompson used a combination dairy feed, containing mill run, oats, corn and oil meal.


