

CONTESTS ANNOUNCED FOR
WASHINGTON CELEBRATION

High and grade pupils throughout Oregon will have opportunity soon to compete in essay and declamation contests in connection with the celebration of the 200th anniversary of the birth of George Washington, announces Dr. J. B. Horner of Oregon state college, who is secretary of a committee of three to arrange such contests for the Oregon celebration commission.

The committee has already announced the details of an oratorical contest among the 17 colleges and universities of the state, with \$100 in cash and several medals offered as prizes. Winners of state contests will enter regional meets and winners of these will go to the national finals in Washington, D. C.

BUTLER MADE S. P.
DINING CAR HEAD

San Francisco, Jan. 15—Appointment of Harry A. Butler as manager of dining cars, hotels and restaurants for Southern Pacific Company, succeeding Allan Pollok, retired, was announced here today by Felix S. McGinnis, vice president of the company in charge of system passenger traffic.

Butler has been assistant manager of the department since 1922 and

has been affiliated with the Southern Pacific commissary for 29 years. He is widely known in railroad circles.

Butler started his career with Southern Pacific in 1902, in a clerical capacity at Los Angeles. In 1913 during joint management of the Union Pacific and Southern Pacific under the Harriman regime, he went to Portland as chief clerk and later as inspector of dining cars for the Union Pacific in that district.

Two years later Butler was transferred to Oakland as inspector for Southern Pacific dining cars and a year later was placed in charge of the Oakland commissary. During Federal control of railroads he was assistant to the dining car manager, with headquarters here. He was appointed as assistant to Pollock on August 1, 1922, with headquarters in Oakland.

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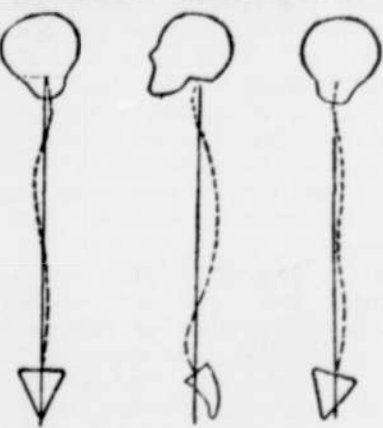
