The cry for inflation is abroad in the land with many responsible citizens advocating some measure to provide for the easy settlement of debts.

## MILLIONS IN MISSING MONEY

According to W. O. Woods, Treasurer of the United States, there is now outstanding \$472,199,000 in old sized bills which have been officially recalled since July, 1929. While about \$7,000,000 per month continues to come in to the Treasury for replacement, it is known that a large of this balance has been lost or destroyed.

It is interesting to observe the enormous sums lost by people every year through carelessness and much of the large money still out will probably never be turned in to the government. This fact is illustrated almost every time a large security issue matures. Inevitably, some of the paper never comes in for payment and while the percentage thus lost is not great in comparison with the amount outstanding, it makes a considerable total.
