## ROOSEVELT'S PROGRAM.

With less than ten days to go before he takes the Presidential office many people are wondering as to exactly what the program of President-elect Roosevelt will be. A writer in the Detroit News states that the following will constitute the Roosevelt program to revive business:

Foremost in the list undoubtedly is the hope of international action which will stabilize currencies, reduce trade barriers, and otherwise promote an upturn in the foreign trade levels, which have been steadily declining since the depression began three and a half years ago. It is to this end that it is proposed to tackle the troublesome issue of war debts as a first step after March 4.

Secondly, Roosevelt would add to the purchasing power of the farmers by some sort of artificial stimulation of prices of basic commodities.

Third, the Democrats are determined to do something to make easier the process of liquidation of debts.

Finally, the Democrats are considering ways and means of broadening the activities of the Reconstruction Finance Corporation with a view of providing jobs for the present unemployed.

## ENDANGERS PEACE.

Only the most foolish would deny the existence of some possibility that this country and Japan will go to war. As long as serious differences exist in regard to the Orient this possibility of conflict will remain.

Japan is not in any mood to abandon its Manchurian adventure. It feels that the United States has been the leader of its critics and the instigator of all opposition from the League of Nations. If Japan goes to war with any occidental nation it will be with America.

In the face of this international situation and the diplomatic policy of our Department of State, which insofar as it concerns the Orient has already been endorsed by President-elect Roosevelt, it would seem that the best possible course to pursue to encourage Japan in making war on this country would be to weaken the American Navy. Yet, that is exactly what our government is now doing.

The proposal has been made to cut naval appropriations further. No wonder Secretary of Navy Adams opposes it as certain to "cripple our national defense for years" and leave us far behind England and Japan in fighting ships. The Secretary says that if this further curtailment of efforts is made 33 combatant ships will have to be taken out of active commission, leaving "in full commission about 66 per cent. of the number of British and 58 per cent. of the number of Japanese ships, which are in full commission, or fully manned."

Japan will fight America much quicker if our Navy is only about one-half as effective as hers than if our Navy is maintained at full treaty strength giving us a superiority of naval strength. That the oriental situation is still precarious and recognized so by our naval officers is shown by the statement of Chief of Naval Operations Pratt that the Atlantic fleet would probably be kept in the Pacific until the first of July, 1934.
