South Producing Food

Food Industries, a magazine published in the interests of commercial foodstuffs, thinks, "Northern food producers are rapidly losing an important market for 'exports'—the South. The depression started a vast movement that appears likely to decrease the dependence of the Southeast on outside sources of supplies of food for both man and animals. It is estimated that about 60 per cent of the winter supply of fruits, vege-

tables and meats required in the Southeast in 1932 was produced in that section. Approximately 50 per cent of the animal feed requirements also was locally grown last year comparing with 15 per cent in 1926-29 period."

Radio Waves Kill Weevil

"High frequency radio waves have proved effective in ridding stored wheat of the destructive weevil. The waves not only kill the insect, but they destroy its eggs and larvae. And it takes only a few seconds to accomplish all this. In laboratory tests made by Westinghouse at the instance of the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad, the weevils were killed almost instantly, and even the eggs and larvae succumbed in six seconds. Radio waves about 5 meters in length were used; these had no effect upon the wheat," says Food Industries.

The investigation was carried into the field, and grain passing through a chute was successfully treated at a rate of 60 bushels an hour. This treatment consumed 13.8 kw of short-wave energy.

These experiments are being continued but as yet the apparatus is not available commercially.

Alfalfa Fertilizers Tried

REDMOND—An elaborate series of alfalfa fertilizer tests has been arranged for this season on the E. L. Davis farm where a new alfalfa tract has been divided into 6 acre plots for the test. One plot will be given sulfur at the rate of 50 pounds an acre. Another will get landplaster at 100 pounds per acre in the spring. A third will receive such an application of landplaster in the spring and an equal amount before the second cutting, while a fourth will get super phosphate at the rate of 100 pounds an acre.
