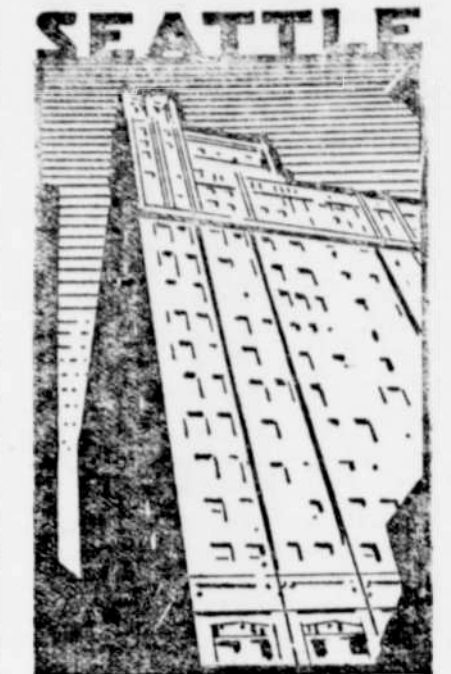

CHEESE HAS MANY USES

Since ancient times cheese has been recognized as a nutritious and satisfying food. Today the many nutritional qualities of cheese, which recommend its frequent use are well known to most housewives. Cheese is a concentrated source of the solids found in milk and therefore, in the daily menu cheese makes important contributions to the protein, calcium, phosphorus and vitamin needs of the body.

Besides these nutritional values, cheese, because it has so many interesting relatives—some with a nippy twang and others with a subtle flavor, comes to the rescue when menu planning becomes a problem. It offers a wide variety of interesting combination with other foods. Cheese puddings, cheese souffles, macaroni and cheese, cheese fondue, cheese with potatoes, corn or rice, cheese in sandwiches, salads are but a few of its possibilities. In fact, cheese whether used by itself or as "cracker" and cheese' dessert, or in combination with other food will add to the flavor and food value of the meal.

Eggs and Noodles au Gratin

4 tbsp. butter
2 tbsp. flour
1-8 tsp white pepper.
2 cups diced celery
1 1/2 cups milk
1 tsp. salt
4 hard cooked eggs
1 cup grated cheese
1 package noodles
Cook noodles in salted water until tender. Make white sauce of flour, milk and seasonings. Brown celery in butter. Put noodles, celery, sliced eggs, and cheese in alternate layers into buttered baking dish. Pour white sauce over all. Sprinkle with grated cheese and paprika. Set in a moderate oven until cheese melts and browns slightly. Serves 6.

Cheese Dreams

2 cups grated cheese
1/2 tsp salt
Dash of pepper
8 slices bread
3 tbsp butter
8 strips bacon
Mix cheese with seasonings. Spread bread with butter and cheese mixture lay strips of bacon over the top, place on a baking sheet, place in a very hot

oven and toast until the cheese is melted and bacon crisp. Serve hot.

Cheese Ring Salad

1 tbsp gelatin
2 cups cottage cheese
1 tsp mustard
1/4 tsp salt
1/4 tsp onion juice
1 cup whipped cream
1/2 tsp paprika
1/4 cup cold water
Soak gelatin in cold water five minutes and dissolve over hot water. Moisten mustard and cottage cheese with 2 tbsp of the cream and work together until smooth. Add dissolved gelatin, salt, onion juice and paprika. Whip the remaining cream and add to the mixture. Turn into a ring mould and chill until firm. Turn on to a salad plate, arranged with lettuce leaves or watercress, garnish with cored pears which have been dipped in French dressing and serve.

Phosphate Boosts Turnip Yield

TOLEDO—Treble phosphate O-20-0 and an ammoniated phosphate 10-52-9 applied at the rate of 160 pounds to the acre, brought an increase of more than 10 tons of Borfield turnips per acre on the E. H. Steinmetz farm at Chitwood in a demonstration trial in which Mr. Steinmetz cooperated with County Agent M. J. Conklin. This was 22 per cent increase in yield on the treated area over the untreated plots. No appreciable difference could be seen in the plants during the growing season, however, the advantage in the treated plots not showing up until weights were taken.

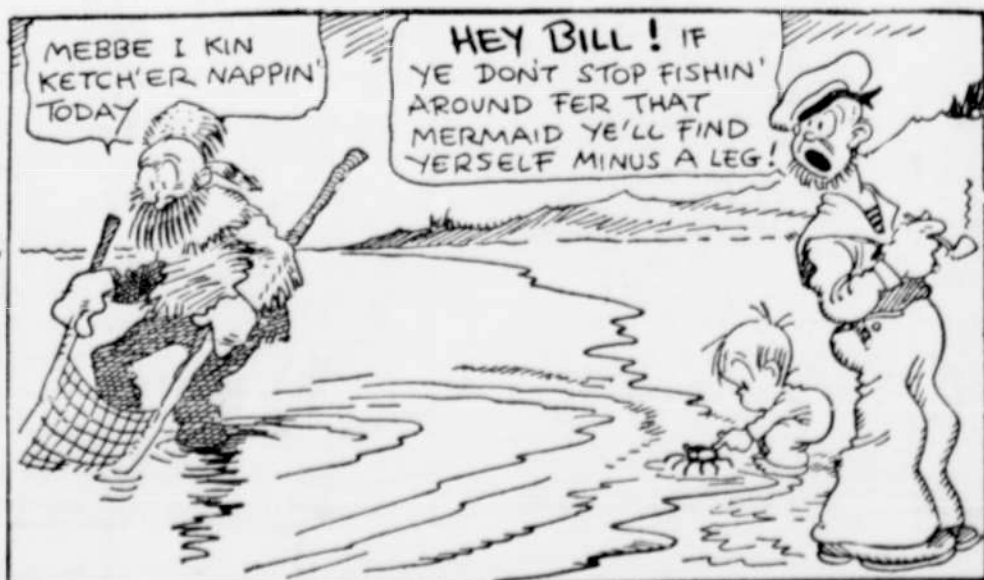
