## Spotted Touch-Me-Not Gypsies' Charm Plant

The jewel-weed or spotted touch-me-not, *Impatiens biflora*, growing in dense jungles along brooks and pond edges, is the favorite plant of gypsies because with it they can work miracles, declares a writer in the New York World-Telegram. "Cross my palm with money," they say, "and I will turn this plant to silver." When you give them the coin they put the jewel-weed under the brook water and it looks silvery. Little bubbles of air cling to the leaves, making them look under water like plated silver. The lovely flowers, each like a little liberty cap, are said to be worn by the fairy, fay, elf and sylph followers of Queen Mab of the Little People at their midnight dances on the flat ledges of the Palisades high above the Hudson. British redcoats, writing home to England during the War of the Revolution about the pesky Yankees fighting in Westchester, said: "Why, when we wake up in the morning after camping beside the Sprain brook the very bushes are covered with liberty caps." The jewel-weed is called *Impatiens* because of its hasty way of sending its children, its seeds, out into the world. When the seed pods are ripe and the little winds come shaking them the mother plant explodes the pods and throws the babies as far away from home as possible. Then at night, in moonlight, every leaf has a penitential teardrop—the dew—clinging to it like a moonstone.

## Petroleum Uses Traced to Zoroaster Followers

The petroleum industry, rising to its heights with the advent of the automobile and the subsequent other types of petroleum-product users, has its roots far back in antiquity, says the Washington Star.

The priests of Zoroaster, ever ready to use any power which would act to their control over the superstitious followers of their religion, built temples over oil and gas fields where seepages from the ground had become ignited. These so-called sacred flames filled the ignorant folk with a terrible awe, and they were held easily under the thumb of the priests of the temple.

The Babylonians used petroleum pitch and oil in defense of their cities against invaders, pouring the burning fluids from their walls down on the soldiers who sought to scale them with ladders.

Many ancient peoples found certain curative properties in petroleum, and they also found that it would burn in the crude lamps of the early days of history.

The first oil well driven in this country was the famous Drake well, which was brought in at Titusville, Pa., in 1859. It was the forerunner of the vast oil industry of the United States.

## Hydrogen Gives Weight to Stars

Not only is about one-third of a star's weight due to hydrogen, but the star is supplied with heat and light by the continued breaking up and rebuilding of the hydrogen atoms. That is the belief of a director of Mount Wilson observatory, who says that in their earlier history stars may have been made entirely of hydrogen clouds. Later, hydrogen atoms condensed to form heavier elements like oxygen, carbon, iron and the like. During this process, enormous energy was released, keeping the star hot and radiant. Spectroscopic study of ironized particles or atoms which have lost their electrons has revealed these secrets of the stars.—Popular Mechanics Magazine.

## Police Man Arctic Posts

About half of Canada's Eskimo population is in the eastern Arctic and over 1,000 of these natives are on Baffin Island. At all the Baffin Island posts, therefore, there are trading stations but the islands farther north have scarcely any permanent native population and the posts there are purely of government administrative purposes and are manned by the Royal Canadian mounted police. From these posts extensive patrols are conducted. The government posts in the eastern Arctic are visited annually by steamship by an expedition sent out by the department of the interior.

## Viking Game Board Found

Harvard archeologists found an ancient Viking game in Ireland. It was found in a Tenth century lake dwelling. The game consists of a board about nine inches square, perforated with 40 round holes. The center hole is surrounded by a double ring, cut in the wood. This board is set inside an ornately carved frame with two wood handles. Each handle is rounded like a doorknob, one almost twice the size of the other. Christian crosses of a type found on the Isle of Man are also on the game board.



## Christmas Greens

Christmas greens! Here's a way to combine some of their color with the festive pink of salmon in a royal dish.  
**Sautéed Salmon Slices with Creamed Peas:** Add one-half teaspoon salt to one and one-half cups boiling water, add one-half cup cornmeal, and cook until thick. Add half the contents of a tall can of salmon, salt and pepper to taste, and a few drops of lemon juice. Place in a greased loaf pan, and let chill. Cut in slices, dip in fine crumbs and sauté in fat until a nice brown. Make a white sauce of two tablespoons butter, two tablespoons flour and one and one-half cups diluted evaporated milk, season to taste, and add the contents of an 8-ounce can of peas. Serve with this sauce poured over the slices. Serves four.

## A Delectable Dish

And here's a delectable dish with green peas in it:  
**Southern Peas and Onions:** Clean one bunch of young onions, and cut off the tops. Then split them lengthwise, and add them with one slice of bacon to half the contents of a No. 2 can of peas. Add three-fourths cup boiling water, and boil until onions are tender. Add more water if necessary. The liquid should be cooked almost away. Remove bacon, season to taste with salt and pepper and serve. Serves four.\*
