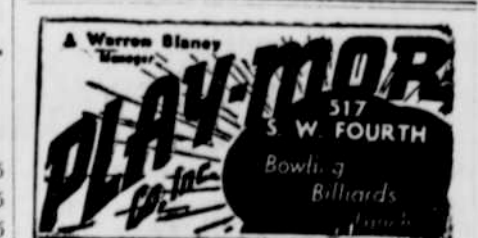
Holiday Plum Pudding
