It took Piluso 6 minutes 20 seconds in the second fall to find the range, a terrific right to the head that sent Williams to the floor. An arm stretch for the pinning fall and they were back on even terms.

An Underground Lighthouse

Brixham is the only place in England, and perhaps in the world, which boasts an underground lighthouse, says London 'Tit-Bits' Magazine. It is situated at Berry Head, more than 300 feet above sea level, with such a wonderful natural position that it has been unnecessary to build higher. The revolving gear is embedded in a solid foundation of rock 30 feet deep, and only the projector shows above the surface. Incidentally, although giving a beam having an intensity of 15,000 candle power, this most modern of searchlights has a burner smaller than most ordinary house mantles. Once set in motion the light revolves automatically, flashing twice every 15 seconds, and on fine nights can be seen more than 30 miles at sea.

Horse Shoes and Nails as Rent

Each year the city of London pays quit rent to the crown for a piece of waste ground known as the Moors, in Shropshire, and a tenement called the Forge, in the parish of St. Clement Danes. The city has long since lost trace of both these properties, but it still pays quit rent. The Moors is paid for in bundles of faggots, which the city solicitor cuts with a new hatchet and a new bill hook. For the Forge he pays six horseshoes and 61 nails. The ceremony takes place in the law courts and payment is received by the king's remembrancer with the words "Good service" and "Good number."
