### To Give Solo Recital



The season's solo recital by a first rank virtuoso pianist will be presented in the Public Auditorium next Thursday, March 19, by Alexander Brailowsky, sensational young Russian genius, who is now making his first American tour in more than five years. Brailowsky, youngest and last of the famous pianistic prodigies developed by the late great Theodore Leschetizky, has been hailed as the most dynamic player to come out of Russia since the glamorous days of Anton Rubinstein. Brailowsky has been called "the passionate poet of the piano"—a reference to the indescribably emotional quality of his playing. As a technician he is unsurpassed by any living pianist, and is possibly the equal of such giants as Liszt and Rubinstein.

The eminent Russian's standing in the world of music is indicated by the number of tours he has made in all part of the civilized world. He has made eight tours of the United States, ten of Continental Europe, five of South America, two of the Far East, as well as single tours of North Africa, Palestine and Australia.
