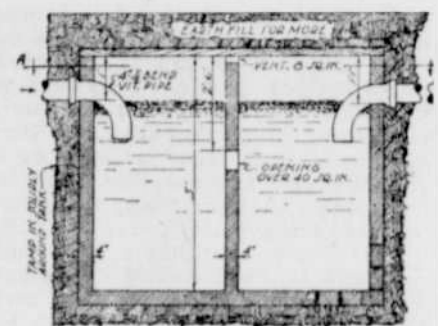
## Permanent Septic Tanks

Brick are not affected by the acids in the sewage and will last almost indefinitely.

The tanks, being built in place of small units, can be made by any brick mason with a minimum of labor or can be built by anyone who has had any experience with brick work.
