to a gas attack.

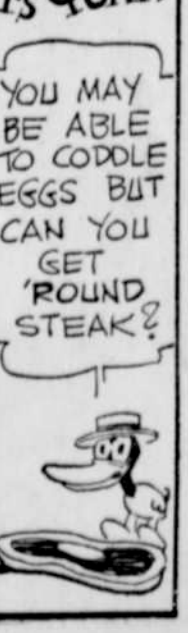
SAVES LIFE; GETS NO THANKS
