Tualatin Flood Control Work to Start Soon

W. G. Ide, chairman of the Wash-
ington County Planning commission
announced last week that the Tualat-
in river flood control project is ex-
pected to be undertaken in the very
near future. Water which formerly
occupied Wapato lake in the spring
now would cause severe floods down-
stream, unless the impeded course is
cleared to allow faster outflow, ac-
cording to reports.
