Last year the average tourist spent about \$4.50 per day against \$10, in 1935. These figures clearly show the trend in American vacations. Low-priced inns, over-night camps, modest beach houses, and lake cottages had a fair season in 1935. This Summer the expensive resorts with their luxurious hotels, club-houses and ranches will have their first real business since 1930.
