How's Your Health?

Your body is composed of about twenty-eight trillion individual cells of different sorts—nervous, muscular, glandular, etc. Each of these cells, believe it or not! is a living, breathing entity. Each must be nourished, each have its waste products carried away. And these are the functions of the blood. The big arteries carry the blood with its content of nourishment and oxygen to the smaller arteries or "arterioles" which in their turn carry it to the capillaries. Thru the walls of the latter go both the nutrients and the oxygen which then flow into the intercellular or "lymph" spaces that exist between every cell and its immediate neighbors. From this fluid or "lymph" each cell then extracts whatever it needs to maintain or rebuild its substance or to replenish its energies; and into this lymph each cell pours its own wastes, to be eventually poured back into the blood stream, which then carries such wastes to the proper purifying and eliminating organs—that is, to the liver, kidneys, lungs and skin.

Coming back to those all-important capillaries for a moment, it can, therefore, easily be seen that whatever improves the capillary circulation thereby improves the nutrition of the various cells. Exercise is one of the best natural ways of improving the capillary circulation, of course. But it sometimes happens, especially in certain diseased conditions, that exercise must be ruled out, and then we have to have some artificial means of improving the capillary circulation. Many such means have been discovered or devised. But unquestionably the best of all these means is that particular form of electricity known as the "short wave". More of this another time; but here a timely warning: Be sure that the short wave is from a spark-gap type machine—not from a tube type one.
