Seed From Canada Makes Joke of Wallace Warning

CHICAGO.—Continued dumping
of Canadian alfalfa and clover seed
makes a "ghastly joke" of the de-
partment of agriculture's warning
against unadapted and misbranded
seed importations, declared Con-
gressman Clifford R. Hope, director
of the Republican National commit-
tee's farm division here.

"This belated warning should
have been sent to the state depart-
ment, rather than the newspapers,"
said Mr. Hope. "Or better, it should
have been issued when Henry Wall-
ace was working with Secretary
Hull on the Canadian trade agree-
ments."

"In the first six months of this
year, the Canadians shipped 618,439
pounds of seed into this country. In
the same period of 1935 they shipped
only 1,780 pounds."

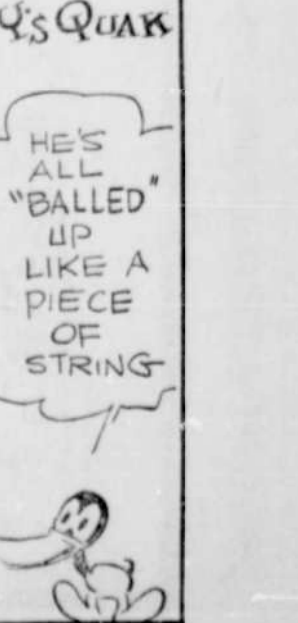
