

FIENDISH MURDERS ARE MYSTERY TO CLEVELAND POLICE

Six Nude Bodies, Decapitated and Limbs Severed, Leave No Clue.

Cleveland. — In September, 1935, two boys scrambled down the steep slopes of Jackass Hill near their home in Cleveland, O., and in an isolated gully they discovered the nude, decapitated bodies of two men. One of these was identified as Edward Andrasz, twenty-eight years old, and the other remains unidentified. They had been killed on different days.

In January, 1936, a dog barking at midnight on Cleveland's east side, attracted attention and brought police to a vacant lot near the downtown area. The nude torso and left arm of a woman were found in two bushel baskets. Finger prints of the hand identified the woman as Mrs. Florence Polilla, forty-one years old. Her head was never found, although the rest of her body was discovered later in a field close by.

Another Body Found. Last June, two men were fishing in Kingsbury Run, a small stream near the spot where the first two bodies were found. They discovered a man's head wrapped in some clothing. The next day, his nude torso was located nearby. He was never identified.

Another nude body of a man was discovered in an isolated gully. He had been dead for three months. His head was found wrapped in a coat forty feet away. No identification was possible.

A sixth dismembered victim was found in Kingsbury Run two weeks ago. It was the body of an unidentified man. His head has not been found.

The Cleveland police see in these six murders, the systematized work of a clever fiend. All the bodies were nude, decapitated, and various limbs severed at the joints. Every trace of identification was carefully removed. All efforts of the twenty-five detectives assigned to the case have proved fruitless. No connection can be found between the crimes and any of the suspects apprehended. However, the police are still searching for a "voodoo doctor," who was arrested in 1928 and charged with a decapitation killing, but acquitted later when the victim could not be identified.

Conference of Physicians. Because the bodies were mutilated carefully and neatly, Coroner A. J. Pearce called together a conference of physicians, psychiatrists, and crime experts to examine every detail of the murders.

The person who beheaded the five men and the woman is believed to possess considerable surgical skill and a professional knowledge of anatomy. In one case, the head was separated from the spine at the junction of two vertebrae. The coroner claims that the hand of a surgeon would have been needed to do the job so neatly without leaving evidence of cutting. He believes the killer is a sex maniac of the sadistic type, and is probably a muscular man.

A solution of the crime seems remote to Sergt. James Hogan of the Cleveland police homicide squad. He said:

"Our chance of solving these decapitation slayings is very slight. Our only hope is for a lucky break."

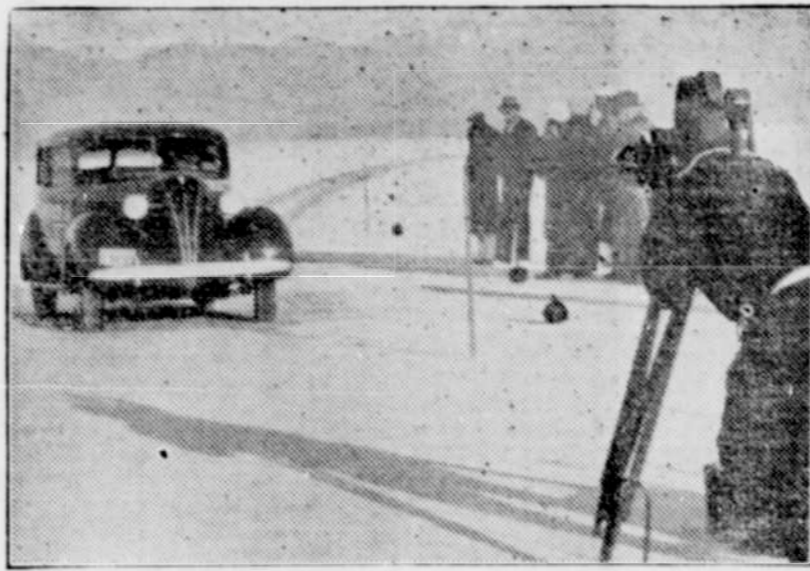
