The old naval treaty between England-Japan-U. S., is, to all intents and purposes, dead. Japan and England are building ships on a vast scale, and the U. S. has announced that she will mount 16-inch guns banned by the treaty on the two super men-of-war now in process of construction.

It is forecast that the Navy Department will request a still bigger appropriation from the next Congress.
