Airmail for Speed

May 15 to 21 inclusive will be Na-
tional Airmail week and people all
over the United States are urged to
observe this occasion by using air-
mail as much as possible and it is
expected Oregon postoffices will
stand in high rank in sale of airmail
stamps during that week.

It takes just 17 hours for a letter to
get to New York City from Port-
land and six hours and 50 minutes
from Portland to Los Angeles and
you can send letters airmail to any
place in the United States and deliv-
ery is made as quickly as possible.
There is only one type of mail that
in handling goes ahead of airmail
and that's a special delivery letter
and an Airmail special delivery let-
ter is the next thing to a telegram
so far as speed is concerned. The
airmail stamp cost six cents. It is
of light orange or salmon color and
is oblong in shape and very much
different in appearance from any
other. Whenever you put an airmail
stamp on a letter, that letter is never
put with other letters in leaving
the postoffice to begin its journey,
but is assembled with airmail and
put ahead of everything else. It is
good business to use airmail.

Kept Burning

In an old palace in Travancore
(India) is an oil lamp which, ac-
cording to tradition, has been burn-
ing for the past 1,200 years. It
commemorates a ruler of the state
who is said to have ascended to
heaven while resting on a stone
couch. The couch is preserved as
an object of veneration.

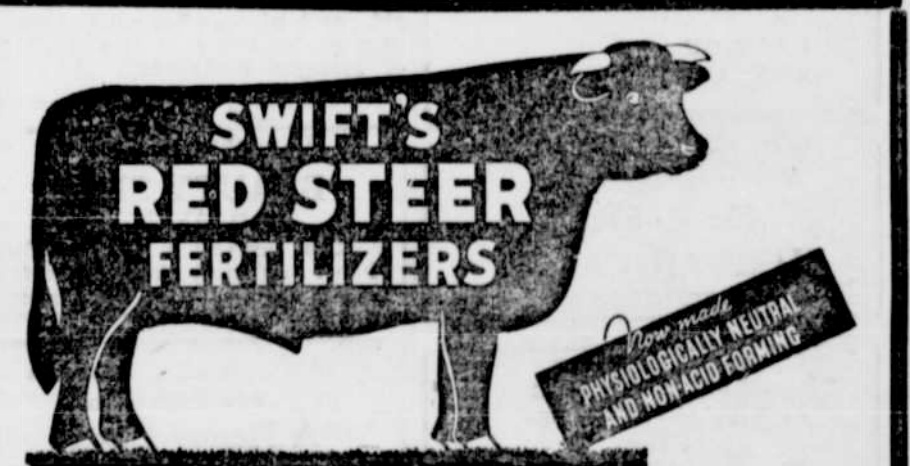
