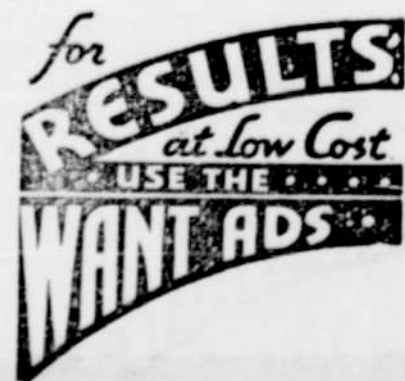

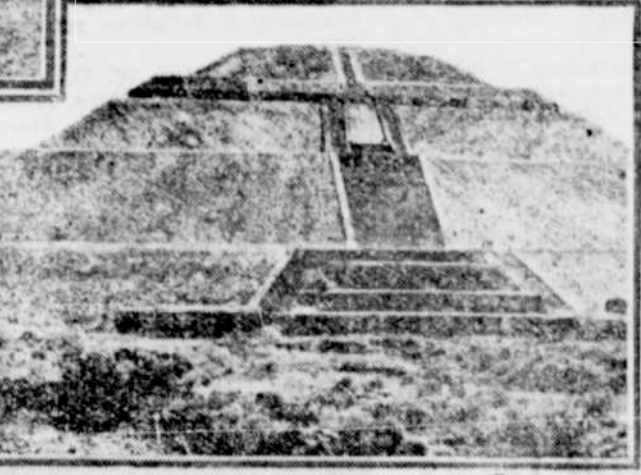

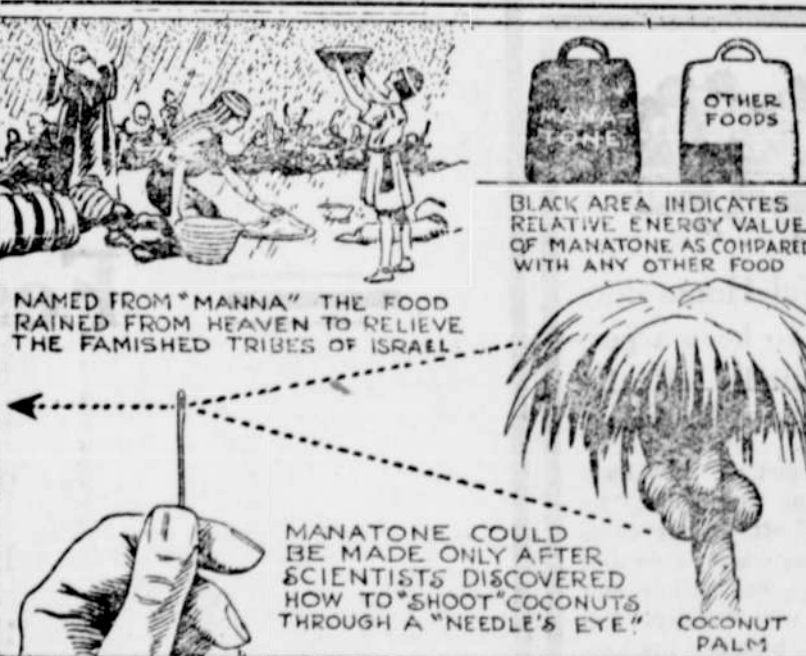

### No, Not a Church Steeple

This strange-appearing tower is the derrick of the world's first producing oil well. Development of the petroleum industry dates back from "Drake's Folly," so called because most folks thought Drake foolish to dig for "flowing gold." He struck oil at 69 feet, but it took him 15 months. This was 78 years ago. Today wells are drilled more than two miles deep in a few weeks, to produce crudes for Mobiloil and other petroleum products.
